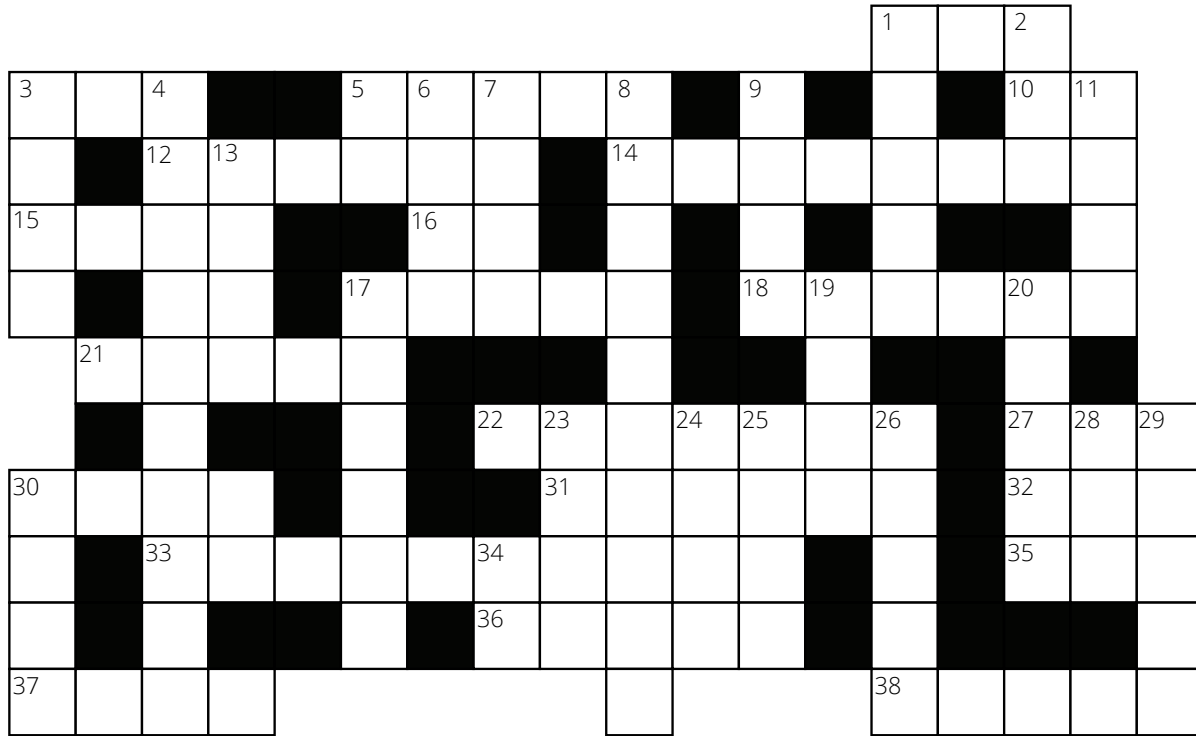

FACTS AND HISTORY

- Greater Forest Lawn is located on the traditional territories of the Métis Nation of Alberta (Region 3) and the peoples of Treaty 7, including the Blackfoot Confederacy (Siksika, Kainai, Piikani), Stoney Nakoda Nations, and Tsuut'ina Nation
- 17 Ave SE was built along a 'section line' which was originally surveyed in 1883
- Forest Lawn and Albert Park amalgamated into one village in 1935. Forest Lawn became a town in 1953, and was annexed by Calgary in 1961
- Mayor Nenshi grew up in Forest Lawn. His family owned a laundromat (now "Forest Lawndry")
- Dover is named after Mary Dover, a historic councillor and environmentalist
- Elliston Park was named after the Ellis family who have lived in the area since 1912
- The International Avenue BRZ was formed in 1993
- The first traffic light on 17 Ave SE was at 36 Street SE, built in 1959

(1) Highest-Shortest: Calgary Tower (1040m elevation + 191m tower), Radisson Place (1065m+40m), Burj Khalifa (16m+828m), Eiffel Tower (35m+300m). (2) Oldest: Forest Lawn (1910), Albert Park (1910), Southview (1950). Largest: Dover (10,910), Marlborough (9,240), Marlborough Park (8,935). (3) Merchant Law is closer to Fort Calgary (3.35km) than Elliston Park (3.5km).
